



Towards a European Defence Union

FROM CLOSER INTEGRATION TO A EUROPEAN ARMY

Europe's security environment has changed dramatically in the past few years. Russia's aggressiveness, persistent instability in the Middle-East and North-Africa, increased terrorist threats within the European Union as well as a shift in the foreign policy priorities of the United States (that could become even more marked as a result of the last presidential elections) changed the basis of EU's seresponsibility for its own security.




