

As a candidate for the European Parliament, I therefore declare that I firmly support:

- the need to equip the European Union with the appropriate competences, autonomous resources and powers (starting with budgetary power) to implement the common policies necessary to defend security, the rule of law, and the social sustainability of the inescapable green and digital transitions, guaranteeing a future of progress for European citizens;
- the overcoming of unanimity and the right of veto through the extension of the ordinary legislative procedure (which implies the strengthening of the European Parliament and the European Commission);
- the need to open a Convention in continuity with what the outgoing European Parliament called for in order to reform the Treaties.

I also declare my willingness, if elected,

- to join the **Spinelli Group**, which in the outgoing legislature animated the political debate on the construction of a more capable and democratic Europe and the work on the drafting of proposals for reforming the Treaties

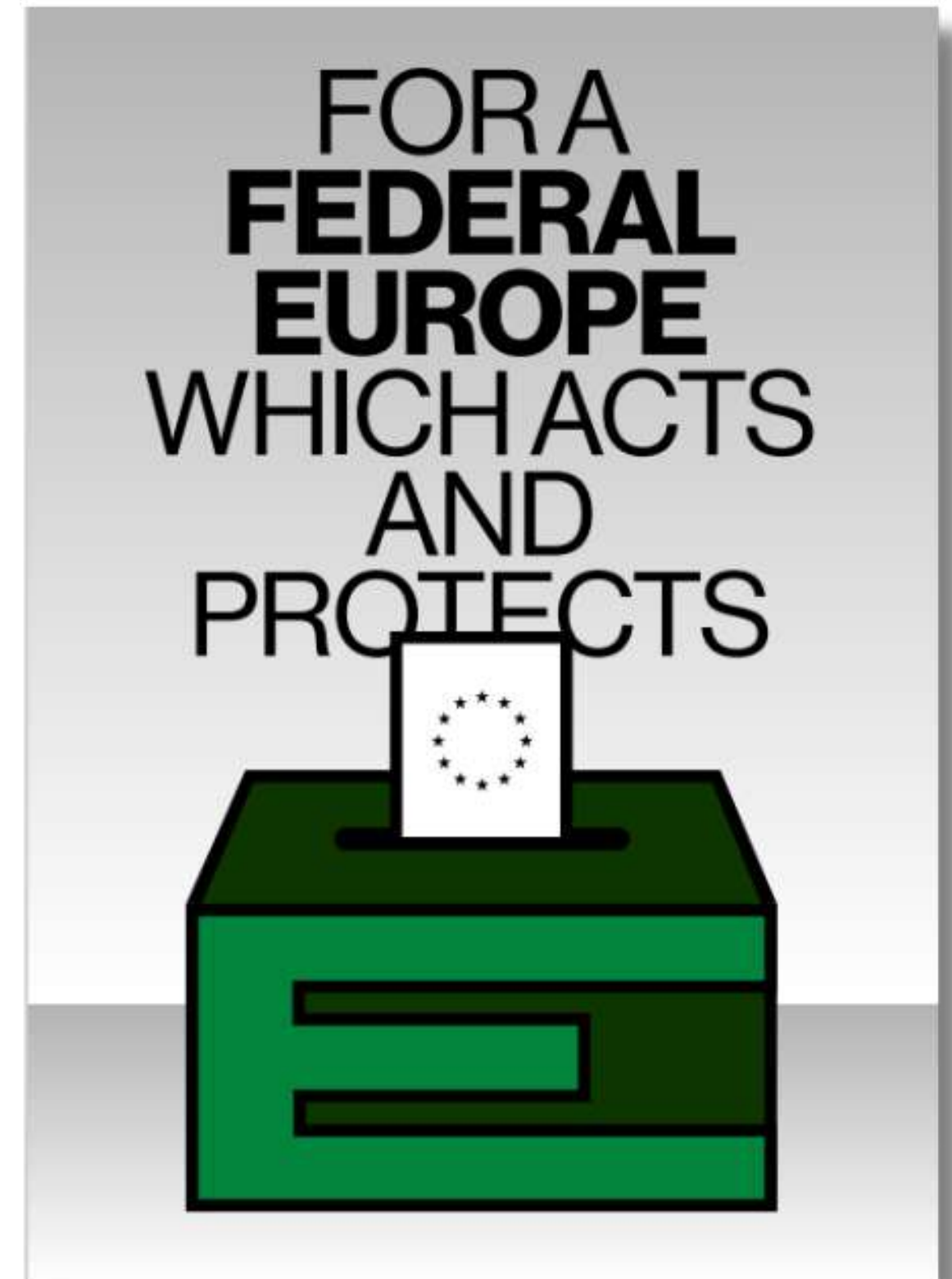
